Marine Tourism and Recreation Forum Discuss the Future of the Industry

With the rise of the marine-based tourism and recreation industry, the biggest challenge of this new sector is to build an **overarching** system that governs a licensing system, **accredited** training courses, skill regulations, and an information platform.

On March 23, NKUST's Marine Affairs Research Center held an event called "**Marine Tourism** and Recreation Forum: Development and Professionals Training." It brought governmental departments and civil groups together to discuss issues regarding the marine-based tourism and recreation sector, ranging from the industry, professional certificates, and training programs to the construction of a maritime tourist information platform.

The forum focused on the marine-based tourism and recreation sector invited government officials and local governments as well as members from non-governmental groups and associations to join the discussions. **Minister Without Portfolio** Audrey Tang was also invited as one of the **keynote speakers**. The forum was set to a **livestream** that attracted online and offline audiences interacting with the officials. As NKUST's Marine Commerce College has done plenty of research on the marine leisure industry, it has been one of the parties that gave suggestions to the government from the policy or industry **perspective**.
